Aim

It is recognised that school uniform plays an important part in the engagement of students at school, in promoting a sense of shared identity, belonging and connectedness. All students are expected to meet the dress code requirements, as endorsed by the School Board. This applies to all Kindergarten to 6 students.

Expectations

Uniform	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Blue and white checked dress. ▪ Navy blue short or skort. ▪ Navy blue skirt. ▪ Navy polo shirt. ▪ Year 6 students wear navy/white polo shirts. ▪ Faction T-shirt for faction events and sport sessions. ▪ Navy blue wide brimmed or bucket hat. ▪ Navy blue zip jacket. ▪ Navy and white spray jacket. ▪ Navy blue track or jazz pants. ▪ Navy blue stockings or tights. ▪ Navy blue scarf. ▪ <i>No black items of clothing allowed.</i> ▪ <i>No hooded jumpers, beanies or caps allowed.</i>
Footwear	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Sport shoes. ▪ Sandals. ▪ <i>No thongs, gumboots, uggs allowed.</i>
Jewellery	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Watch. ▪ Standard necklace or bracelet- under clothing. ▪ Small studs or sleeper's earrings. ▪ <i>No makeup or fake nails.</i> ▪ <i>If a smart watch is worn, it must not be used to message or call during school hours.</i>
Hair	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Hair is brushed, neat and tidy. ▪ Long hair must be tied up and kept off the front of the face.
